


Introduction:

- Three OCA Cultural Centers have theaters: South Dallas CC, Bath House CC, & Latino CC
- These are invaluable resources to nurture our small theater companies and we have reached capacity at BHCC & LCC:
 - BHCC 50 weeks used in FY 2016-17
 - LCC 47 weeks used in FY 2016-17
 - SDCC 43 weeks used in FY 2016-17
- Cultural Centers build their FY "seasons" around core groups and regular festivals, such as the FIT at BHCC and Hispanic Heritage Month at LCC:
 - Core Groups' formal requests for dates occurring now
- Utilization (# of tickets sold per event) is also tracked, especially at the LCC which has 300 seats



LCC was utilized 47 weekends per year in FY 2016-17




Red: LCC "Core Groups"



BHCC was utilized 50 weeks in FY 2016-17




Yellow: BHCC Programming





- All neighborhood support for arts, including cultural center and support in other art spaces is part of the Cultural Plan:
 - LCC Phase II will present an opportunity for groups to present in a smaller and large theater
 - The Cultural Plan is looking at the role the City should plan in facilities management – maybe rent subsidies in non-City owned buildings makes more sense??
