Review Panel Roster Nominations

Every year the City of Dallas Office of Arts and Culture (OAC) awards funding to non-profit organizations and individual artists through various funding programs. As a part of that funding process, we assemble review panels to help review and score the applicants. Serving as a panelist is a volunteer commitment done through either a full-day in-person review process or a remote review of applications. All panelists will go through an orientation to explain the requirements of being a panelist as well as an explanation of the funding program and scoring criteria for the program they are participating in as a panelist. Depending on the funding program, a panelist's time commitment may range from 10-15 hours total for application review, scoring, and applicant question and answer sessions.
