During Katanga's visual arts workshops, participants will experience art/creativity as a way of thinking. They will learn the historical background and the function of art. During the exploration process, they will design processes using geometrical, color selection, as well as rhythmic line patterns; utilizing recyclables such as, cardboard, wood remnants and string. Participants will create and customize the drawings before the flip drums construction phase. During additional sessions, participants will understand the needs for community, construct animals, tambourines and other objects from recycled materials, and delve into the myths and misconception of art as a therapeutic tool.
