## VISUAL ARTS WORKSHOPS

**Selestino Barron offers the following Mexican Folk Art workshops:**

- 1) Papel Picado/Cut Paper Designs - Participants will fold, cut, and paste paper to produce a design of their own: A pop-up card and a mini banner.**
- 2) God's Eye/Ojos de Dios - Participants will use 2 wooden sticks and a string of yarn to make one of the oldest forms of weaving. Then they will add feathers and beads to finish the God's Eye.**
- 3) Corn Husk Dolls - Participants will learn to manipulate corn husks into a figure of a male or female doll. They can add a hat, a bag, and/or walking stick to make it unique.**
- 4) Nerika/Yarn Painting - Participants will learn to glue yarn on a 12" cardboard round. The designs will be made with a stencil.**
- 5) Chaquira/Seed Painting - Participants will learn how to glue beans onto a bowl to make a decorative pattern to create a ceremonial bowl.**
