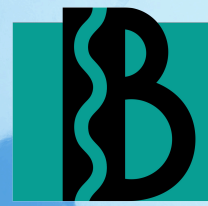

Made in Plastic II explores the relationship between art, nature, and human consumption habits. Through their work, the artists seek to raise awareness about environmental impact, encourage reflection on sustainable practices, and inspire viewers to reconsider the consequences of “single-use plastic.” The exhibition features a diverse collection of paintings, installation art, wall mobiles, drawings, prints, crochet rugs, and three-dimensional mixed-media works created with found plastic objects.

Second Surface: Shaping New Futures from Plastic Waste

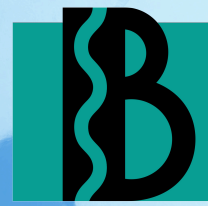

**“The World is Ours” at
FIFA Fan Fest™**

**June 11 – July 19, 2026
Big Tex, Fair Park**

Selected as one of the eleven awardees of the “Arts Projects Spotighting the Spirit of Sports” grant, this award will support projects that are coordinated by the host cities of the FIFA World Cup 2026™.

Of the projects there is a range from performances, exhibitions, concerts, festivals, and educational programming.



“The World is Ours” by artists Risk Rock and Mesplé is a large-scale sculpture measuring eight feet wide and twelve feet high. The work features a bold bronze hand lifting an immense, gently rotating globe. The globe itself is engineered from repurposed spray cans and embellished with vibrant license plates collected from around the world. This fusion of art and engineering invites viewers to engage with the work through curiosity, cultural recognition, and a sense of shared global identity. The sculpture reflects the spirit of international sport by symbolizing how global communities come together through shared experiences such as the World Cup™.

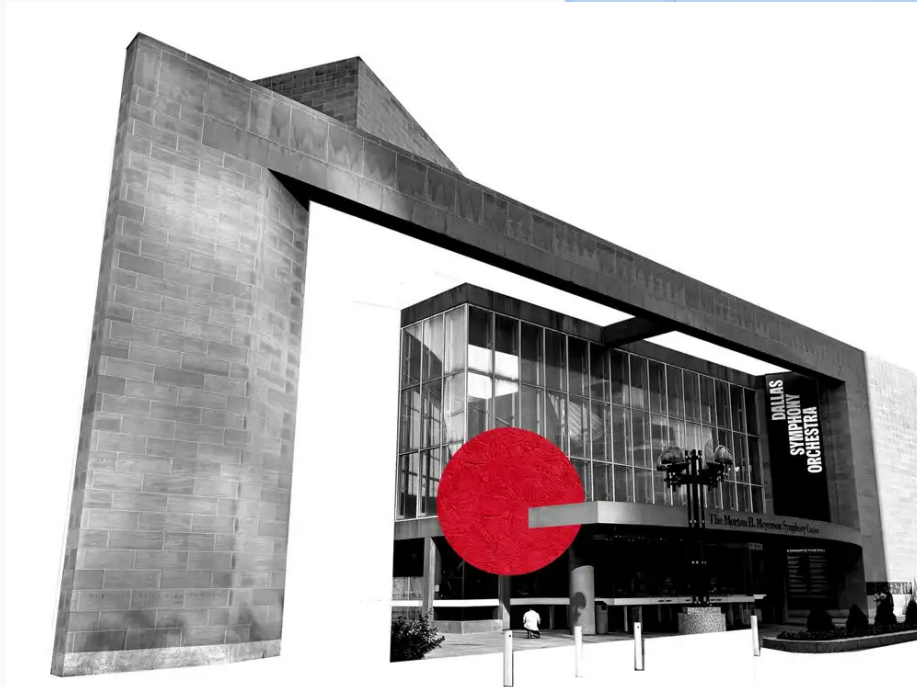

**“RedBall Dallas” by artist Kurt Perschke

RedBall Project by artist Kurt Perschke is an ongoing temporary public artwork and performance featuring a 15-foot inflatable red sphere that moves daily through a city, appearing at publicly shared locations, and inviting both planned and unexpected encounters in public space. For ten consecutive days, the iconic RedBall will travel throughout the Dallas Arts District and surrounding downtown locations, transforming streets, cultural landmarks, and everyday passageways into sites of curiosity, imagination, play, and shared discovery.
