María Candelaria (NR)

María Candelaria (1944) tells the tragic story of an ostracized indigenous woman in early 1900s Xochimilco, Mexico, who, despite being the daughter of a rumored prostitute, loves and wants to marry the honest Lorenzo Rafael, but they face exploitation by the local merchant Don Damián and societal scorn, leading to theft, malaria, imprisonment, and ultimately, mob violence and her death, all framed by an artist's tale about the painting that immortalized her tragic beauty. Selena y los Dinos (PG)

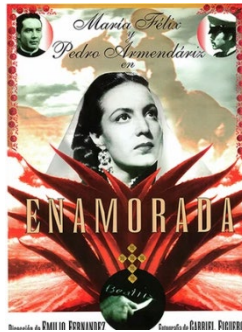

El Bolero de Raquel (NR)

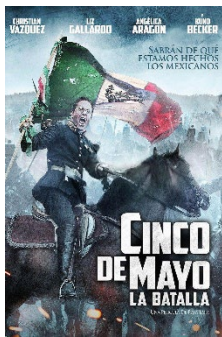

Los Tres García (NR)

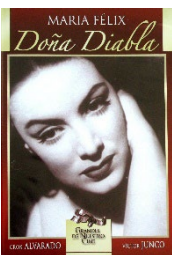

Dona Diabla (G)

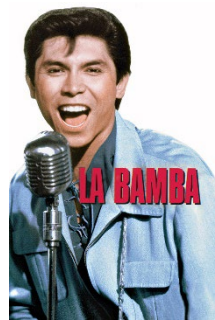

El Vampiro (NR)

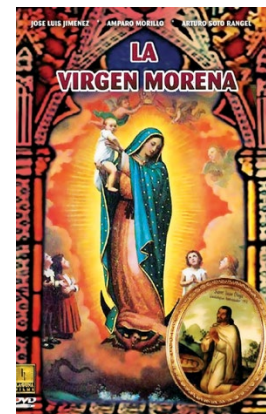
