Entry Deadline: Friday, September 3rd, 2021 – 11:59pm – NOT A POSTMARK DEADLINE

LGBTQIA+ Artists and LGBTQIA+ Allies are encouraged to submit artworks for the exhibition.

We are seeking artwork that expresses authentic and diverse viewpoints from the LGBTQIA+ experience. Artists are encouraged to show us what being an LGBTQIA+ person to them and express what their Pride looks like.

In the spirit of inclusion, this call is open to individuals of all ages. While we welcome all subject matter, it is important that adults and guardians understand the content of the final exhibit may include work that is mature in nature. We will strive to find the right balance between freedom of expression and age-appropriate inclusivity. We encourage the parents/guardians of non-adult artists to preview the exhibit prior to their children viewing it with them. In this way, each parent may decide individually what they want their children to view.

If you do not self-identify as Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual, Transgender, Queer, Questioning or Intersex but are a Caregiver or an Ally, and adhere to the exhibition theme you may also submit artwork for consideration.

Use of Imagery

The Oak Cliff Cultural Center and Texas Latino Pride reserve the right to use artwork images from the exhibition for marketing and publicity without compensation to the artist. Artist credit will be given on any works used for marketing and publicity purposes.

Entries

Art must fit in a 36" x 36" space. Art in all media will be considered. All two-dimensional art must be properly wired and suitable for hanging. All three-dimensional art must be ready for exhibit. Media-based exhibitions will be considered, provided that the exhibitor can provide all the necessary technological equipment to support the exhibition. Priority will be given to exhibitions of work by professional artists.

Entries will be accepted via email in the form of high-resolution JPEG file – Please email your submission to oakcliffculturalcenter@gmail.com

Please label your file submissions by using your last name and sequential number: 1, 2, 3, etc. (Example: smith1.jpeg, smith2.jpeg)

Total Entries Per Person – Maximum: 3



Entry Fee: There is no entry fee.

Artists must submit at least one “Artist Statement” that explains the inspiration for their work(s).

Submissions must be the artist’s original work.

The use of any model for photography must be accompanied with a model release form. Models must also be 18 years or older. In addition, nude photography is not permitted for this exhibition.

Please email an Artist Statement, JPEG file examples of work being submitted, and Artist bio. A complete submission is due to the Oak Cliff Cultural Center by Friday, September 3rd, 2021 – 11:59pm. This is not a postmark date.
