The Bath House Cultural Center presents new exhibition series “Paint NTX” featuring North Texas Artists

On view through April 25, 2026

Dallas - The Bath House Cultural Center presents “Paint NTX”, a new exhibition series that highlights traditional painting in the digital age. This exhibition highlights the work of 32 painters from throughout the North Texas region, plus two guest artists from other regions of Texas. This exhibition is free and open to the public.

The artists featured in “Paint NTX”, together reflect the richness and range of contemporary painting practices. Featured works offer a snapshot of how this time-honored medium continues to evolve through distinct voices and individual visions. The exhibition’s central aim is to showcase the range, power, and vitality of artists who use painting as a means of expression. “Paint NTX” emphasizes the expressiveness and multifaceted explorations of paint, as well as the medium’s ability to communicate complex ideas, emotions, and narratives across time and culture.

Many of the artworks on view are largely narrative and representational, presenting stories rooted in lived experience, memory, and imagination. The show will also present examples of abstraction and non-figurative art, where form, color, and gesture operate as eloquent communicators of meaning and story without reliance on literal depiction. This dialogue between representation and abstraction underscores the flexibility and depth of painting as an artistic language.

At a moment marked by the rapid digitalization of art, the rise of artificial intelligence, and an increasing preference for screen-based imagery, *Paint NTX* reflects on and celebrates traditional painting as a still-powerful conveyor of meaningful messages. The exhibition affirms painting’s continued relevance and its capacity to engage viewers through material presence, intentionality, and the unmistakable touch of the human hand.
